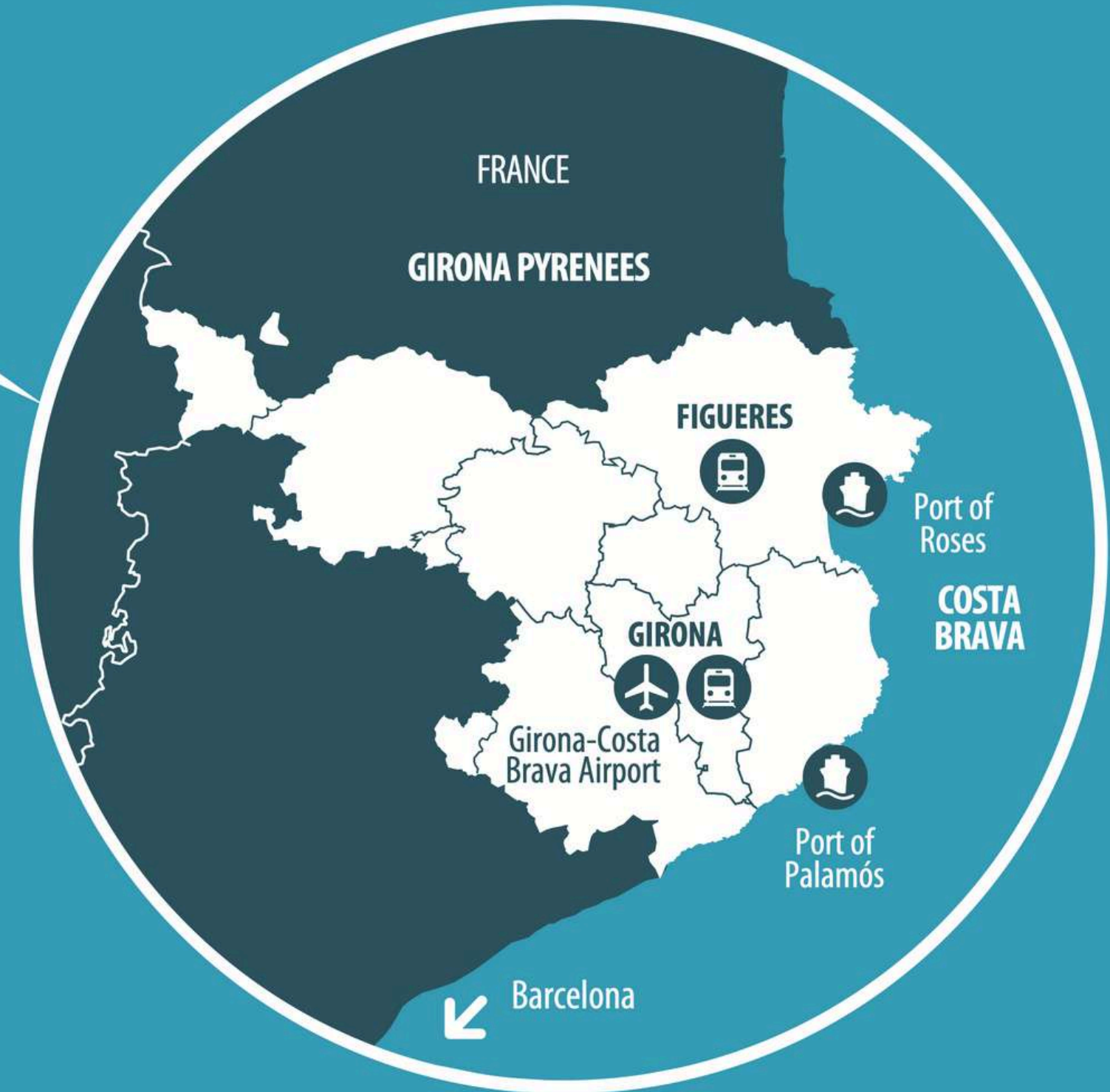

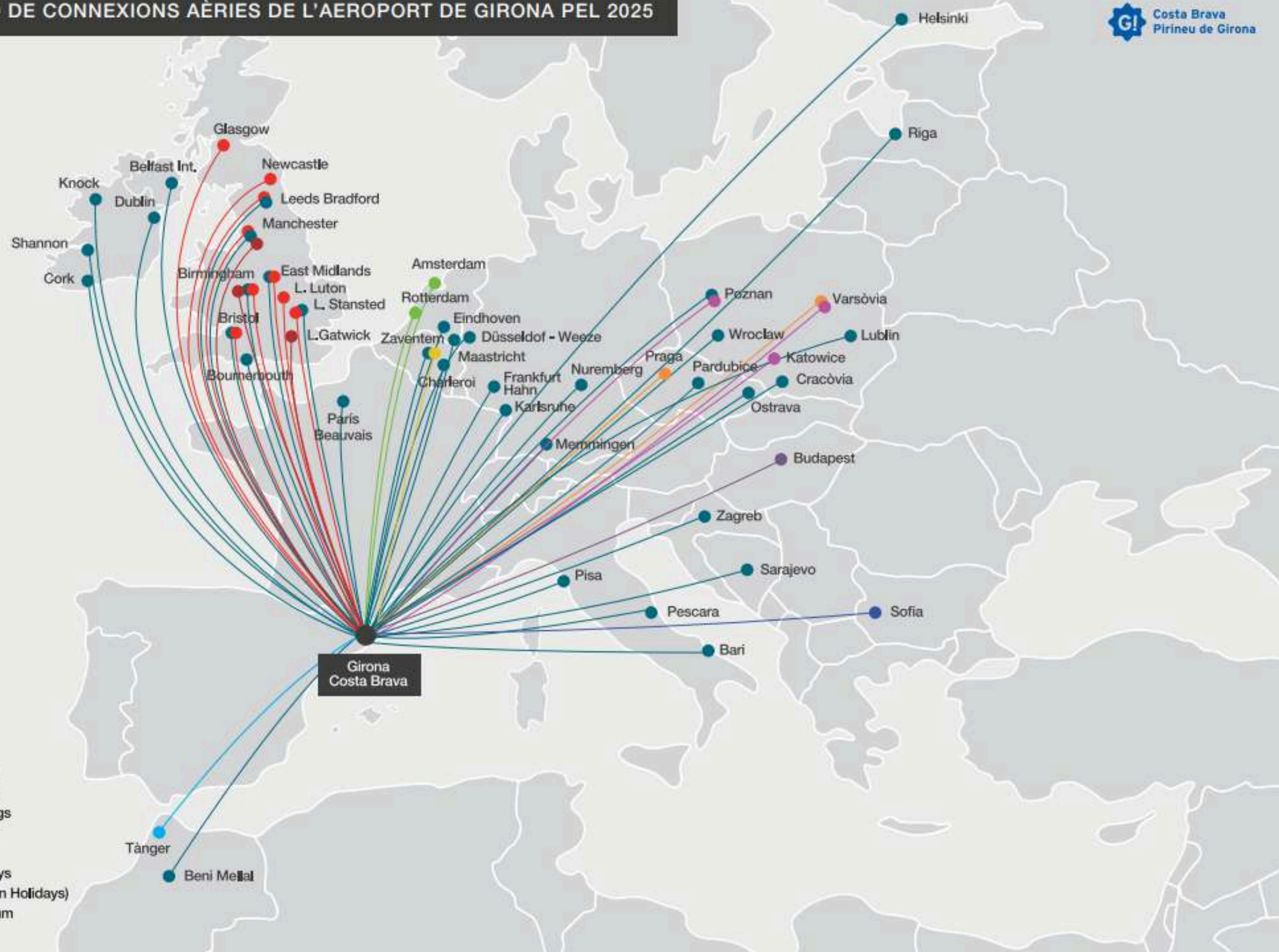

Help small land stewardship producers

EMYS FOUNDATION

3 hours
 Spring (April-May) and autumn (October-November)

The Emys Foundation has signed a dozen land stewardship agreements with local organic crop and livestock farmers. Our main goal is to work with them to implement ecological farming and livestock practices with high nature value (HNV) that are capable of sustaining high levels of biodiversity, which in turn aids conservation. The organisation has been working for many years with a programme to foster land stewardship. However, many small farmers who want to apply ecological and HNV practices have very few resources available to make the necessary investments and changes on their properties. We aim to support the Emys Foundation's land stewardship producers so that they can adapt their properties and carry out possible actions to promote ecological farming in Selva county.

Sand traps. Restoring the dune system in the bay of L'Estartit-Pals

HUMANSIDE EXPERIENCES

2-3 hours
 Year-round
 Min. 12 / Max. 80
 Starting from €35 / pers.

Project to restore the dune ridge in the bay of L'Estartit-Pals to recover a protected habitat that is home to endemic species. The aim is to restore the ecosystem functionality following the loss of sand outside the beach-dune system and, by doing so, protect the natural beaches as a fundamental asset of the Baix Ter - Montgrí Natural Park.

Together with the natural park's rangers, this activity mainly involves creating sand traps that need to be rebuilt in different zones of the Ter river gorge. Participants dig 70cm deep trenches in 5 metre sections, hammer in fixing stakes and attach the cane fencing to this structure before filling in the rest of the trench. Thanks to these structures, during storms sand is blown into the traps, but cannot drift out again, thereby establishing the dune system.
